- A SUITE of Problems:
- Conflation between smuggling and trafficking Lack of reliable data – statistics – true impact assess
- Lack of victim identification (especially in labour
- trafficking) less visible.. Bonded labour
- Seen as a social welfare issue not a crime.
- No specialist units effective law enforcement & prosecution often compromised/corruption
- Lack of sustainability police trainings
- No incentive for victims to cooperate (dangerous, no witness protection, no compensation, shelters)
- Focus on databases/hotlines/awareness-raising overlanning programming

Victim-Centered Approach: **Immigration Relief**

Short-Term Relief

- Continued Presence
 - o Only federal law enforcement agencies can apply
 - o Granted by ICE
 - o Can provide refugee-like benefits

Long-Term Relief

- T Visa
 - o Only for trafficking victims
 - o Self-petitioned by victim
 - o Good for up to 4 years
 - o Limited to 5,000
- U Visa
 - o Similar to T visa (but covers 28 crimes)
 - o Must have LE certification

- UNIAP and COMMIT Process (Mekong Sub-region)

 - Police liaisons/attache working group precursor to Virtual **Global Taskforce**









Measure Increases Maximum Criminal Penalties For Human Trafficking

	Current Law	Proposition 35
Prison Sentence ^a		
Labor trafficking	5 years	12 years
Sex trafficking of an adult, forced	5 years	20 years
Sex trafficking of a minor without force	None	12 years
Sex trafficking of a minor, forced	8 years	Life term
Sentence Enhancement ^a		
Great bodily injury	6 years	10 years
Prior human trafficking offense	None	5 years per prior conviction
Actual penalty includes a range of years.	Up to \$100,000 for sex trafficking a minor	Up to \$1.5 million for all human trafficking offenses
